

## **Eyelid Entropion (Inverted Lower Eyelid)**

Eyelid entropion refers to an inward rotation of the eyelid. The lashes can often rub up against the eyeball or globe. This can result in irritation, redness and sensitivity to wind and light. Patients often complain they feel something in their eye. Left untreated damage to the cornea of the eye may occur.

Correction of eyelid ectropion varies upon the etiology and extent of the condition. Evaluation by your oculoplastic or reconstructive surgeon will determine which surgical procedure is best for you. Most corrections are performed as outpatient procedures. Recover is often quick and symptoms are usually improved in short order.
